Each year, juniors and seniors are allowed 2 "college days" to visit prospective institutions. It is the student's responsibility to monitor the number of college days available. Taking more than 2 days per year will count against exemptions and excessive absences.

If a seal is not available, <u>DOCUMENTATION ON LETTERHEAD MUST ACCOMPANY THE FORM.</u> BUSINESS CARDS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- 3. This form must be submitted to the Attendance Office within 3 days upon returning to school.

#### Admission

- Do you have an enrollment deadline?
- What criteria do you use for acceptance?
- Do I need to take an admissions exam?
- When may I tour the campus?

#### Academics

- What majors/programs do you offer?
- What is the average length of your programs?
- · What percent of students who enroll graduate?
- · Do you have any international programs?
- Will I have an advisor to help me with scheduling?
- Is tutoring available?

#### Financial Aid

- · What financial aid is available?
- · How do I apply?
- · Do you have a financial aid deadline?
- Are there any scholarships available through your college?
- What is the total cost of tuition, books, etc. for the program I'm interested in?

#### **Career Services**

- · What type of job placement assistance do you offer?
- Do you offer part-time job assistance?
- · What is your placement rate?
- What types of jobs are your graduates getting?

#### Student Life

- What type of housing is available?
- · How many students attend your school?
- What is the average class size?
- What are some of the student organizations?
