
# Go Apply Texas Application Step-By-Step for Dual Credit

- 1. Go Apply Texas: Create an account or login www.goapplytexas.org
  - a. First Time Here? "Create and Account" or "Already have an Account?" and then just login.



- b. Create Your Username and WRITE it down!
- c. **Email** Use your own personal email account that you can access! You will have to verify your account! (DO NOT use your GWISD email.)
- d. **Create your own password:** 12 characters with an upper case, lower case, special character, and number WRITE IT DOWN! You will use this same account your senior year when you apply for schools after high school.
- 2. Click "Start/Edit Your Profile"

Please note: your email address also serves as a login option (in addition to the username you chose when signing up). Changing your email address will require verifying the new

email address and you will only be able to log in using your username if you don't verify it. You must verify your email to submit applications.


Select "Del Mar College" from the list

Select your first-choice school – You will pick "Del Mar College Majors"


Select your first choice major – You will pick "Liberal Arts Degree" and it will automatically show the deadline Click "Select choices and start application"



A new window will open and you will see "Del Mar College Fall 2022" in blue and outlined in gold. You will click on the "+Admissions application"


