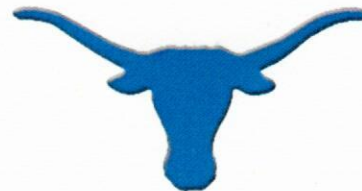




# George West High School

## College Day Form



Each year, juniors and seniors are allowed 2 “college days” to visit prospective institutions. *It is the student’s responsibility to monitor the number of college days available. Taking more than 2 days per year will count against exemptions and excessive absences.*

### Directions:

1. Notify the attendance office or administrator prior to your visit.
2. Complete Part I of this form prior to the visit. Take the form with you to the college/university you will be visiting and get a signature AND seal or official stamp. If a seal is not available, DOCUMENTATION ON LETTERHEAD MUST ACCOMPANY THE FORM. BUSINESS CARDS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE.
3. This form must be submitted to the Attendance Office within 3 days upon returning to school.

## Checklist For A College Visit

- Meet with an Admission Counselor
- Take a campus tour
- Verify admission requirements
- Meet with a professor in your academic program
- Attend a class
- Talk with students and faculty
- Determine actual college costs
- Meet with a Financial Aid Advisor
- Determine your chances for success: admission, graduation, and placement.

## Suggested Questions To Ask A College Representative

### Admission

- Do you have an enrollment deadline?
- What criteria do you use for acceptance?
- Do I need to take an admissions exam?
- When may I tour the campus?

### Academics

- What majors/programs do you offer?
- What is the average length of your programs?
- What percent of students who enroll graduate?
- Do you have any international programs?
- Will I have an advisor to help me with scheduling?
- Is tutoring available?

### Financial Aid

- What financial aid is available?
- How do I apply?
- Do you have a financial aid deadline?
- Are there any scholarships available through your college?
- What is the total cost of tuition, books, etc. for the program I'm interested in?

### Career Services

- What type of job placement assistance do you offer?
- Do you offer part-time job assistance?
- What is your placement rate?
- What types of jobs are your graduates getting?

### Student Life

- What type of housing is available?
- How many students attend your school?
- What is the average class size?
- What are some of the student organizations?
